

2016 Colorado Karting Tour Competition Rules

Colorado Junior Karting Club

Local option rules for the all other racers

The rules set forth below will govern each Colorado Karting Tour competition in the Colorado Junior Karting Club series.

SPIRIT & INTENT

The rules and guidelines in this amended rulebook are subject to the terms "Spirit and Intent". The guidelines herein are not road maps of legal loopholes so that competitors may "cheat legally". Any policy, rule or procedure that has been in use for 90-days by the club whether written or unwritten, will not be protestable or appealable based solely on semantics, and shall be interpreted based on the spirit and intent of said policy, rule or procedure. The club is not, and does not wish to become, an organization dealing with internal or external and technicalities.

SPORTSMANSHIP

The club competitors, crew and officials are the guests of host racing venues. As guests and professionals, we are expected to exhibit the highest level of sportsmanship. Karting is and will be a family sport; any actions by any competitor and/or crew member at any Club event or function that could have adverse effects on the insurance of the host facility, is detrimental to the Club or displays flagrant misconduct, will be subject to a review by the Race Director and at their discretion a penalty could be assessed, up to and including ejection from the event, disqualification of participant, future suspension of participant and/or crew member.

RULES

The rules of the IKF as set forth in the IKF Competition Regulations and Technical Manual and as amended by the Club herein shall govern each competition of the Club series. In the event of a conflict between the IKF rules and the amendments of the Club, the Club amendments shall govern.

AMENDMENTS

Colorado Karting Tour within the Colorado Junior Karting Club

A. LO 206 Cash Prizes

- i. All CJKC members who finish the 325# 385# L.O. 206 main will be entered in a drawing for \$150. Drawing will be help at the end of the Trophy Ceremony. Must be Present to win.
- ii. Cash Prize Rules
 - a. To be eligible for a cash prize the winner must be a **CJKC Member** prior to qualifying on race day.
 - b. **Must be 18 to win cash prize.** If a driver under the age of 18 wins a cash prize they will not be awarded a cash prize but will receive 2 discounted CJKC race entries (\$10 apiece) to be used at later dates.
 - c. CJKC reserves the right to change the rules at any time.

B. CKT Classes and Local Rules

- i. In an attempt to make the race program run as efficient as possible, classes may race concurrently.
- ii. Karts that do not qualify within an existing class may be permitted to race, but must start all races from the rear of the field, will not collect points and will not be eligible for class prizes or awards. Additional classes can be formed with a minimum of 6 entries.
- iii. Adults are responsible for providing their own transponder and ensuring it functions properly.
- iv. All entrants will present kart, helmet, suit, gloves and neck collar for a pre-race inspection.
- v. It is required that any part, bolt or item that calls for safety wire, cotter pin or snap ring must be secured properly see tech inspection paper
- vi. The correct Colorado Karting Tour decal must be on the front of the kart.
 - a. This will be given out at registration and good for the entire season
- vii. The intent of the TAG and shifter class is to allow everyone with a safe kart to race. The TAG class is for all TAG engines that may have different fuel octane and oil ratio requirements. The same goes for the shifter class where there may be older built moto based karts and stock Honda based karts. CJKC strongly rejects the use fuel additives. Fuel additives for performance enhancement are dangerous to both racer and your fellow competitors. Any racer suspected of using altered fuel may be subject to further inspection. Penalties may be imposed up to exclusion from all future CJKC events.

- ii. Minimum 365lbs
- iii. Unaltered Race Fuel
- iv. MG Yellow Tires
- v. Full Rear width bumpers
- vi. Rear brakes only
- vii. Maximum Rear track width 55 1/8
- viii. Rules are subject to change to ensure a competitive and safe event.

D. Open Shifter Rules

- i. Ages 12 and up
- ii. Maximum 125cc 2 stroke or 250cc 4 stroke engines
- iii. Minimum 385lbs
- iv. MG Yellows
- v. Unaltered Race Fuel
- vi. Maximum Rear track width 55 1/8
- vii. Rules are subject to change to ensure a competitive and safe event.

E. All Rotax Classes

F. L.O. 206 Rules

- i. Ages 12 and up
- ii. Minimum weight 325lbs and 385lbs
- iii. Full Size Chassis
- iv. Duro Tires 710/11-5 rear, 450/10-5 front
- v. Centrifugal drum style clutch with shoes only
- vi. Rear brakes only
- vii. Full width rear bumper
- viii. Spec Fuel Shell V 91
- ix. Spec Oil Briggs 4T
- x. Maximum Rear track width 55 1/8
