

2015 Adult Competition Rules

Colorado Junior Karting Club

Local option rules for the Adult racers

The rules set forth below will govern each ADULT competition in the Colorado Junior Karting Club series.

SPIRIT & INTENT

The rules and guidelines in this amended rulebook are subject to the terms "Spirit and Intent". The guidelines herein are not road maps of legal loopholes so that competitors may "cheat legally". Any policy, rule or procedure that has been in use for 90-days by the club whether written or unwritten, will not be protestable or appealable based solely on semantics, and shall be interpreted based on the spirit and intent of said policy, rule or procedure. The club is not, and does not wish to become, an organization dealing with internal or external litigation and technicalities.

SPORTSMANSHIP

The club competitors, crew and officials are the guests of host racing venues. As guests and professionals, we are expected to exhibit the highest level of sportsmanship. Karting is and will be a family sport; any actions by any competitor and/or crew member at any Club event or function that could have adverse effects on the insurance of the host facility, is detrimental to the Club or displays flagrant misconduct, will be subject to a review by the Race Director and at their discretion a penalty could be assessed, up to and including ejection from the event, disqualification of participant, future suspension of participant and/or crew member.

RULES

The rules of the IKF as set forth in the IKF Competition Regulations and Technical Manual and as amended by the Club herein shall govern each competition of the Club series. In the event of a conflict between the IKF rules and the amendments of the Club, the Club amendments shall govern.

AMENDMENTS

1. Adult Classes within the Colorado Junior Karting Club

In an effort to continue to provide and improve fun family racing PPKRC and CJKC have decided to merge. While the main focus will continue to be promoting youth racing, adults will still have their place on the schedule. The shifter and TAG classes will remain open with only minimal weight and safety rules enforced and the adult L.O. 206 class ages 12 and up will continue to grow. The schedule will consist of all Colorado tracks including two night races at GJMS and Action Karting. All 2015 events, stories and wins will be celebrated at the year-end banquet with Class Champions for all ages.

Cash Prizes

There will be a \$150 cash prize for the winner of the Senior LO206 class at five select races during the 2015 racing season. Please read "2015 Senior CJKC Classes & Local Rules" & "Senior L.O. 206 Podium Cash" for rules, eligibility and cash prize event dates

** Track rules prevent some TAGs and Shifters from being eligible to participate. If your Rotax or Spec Honda is eligible please join us on those dates however no CJKC points will be awarded for the TAGs or Shifter classes on May 17 and Sept 13.

**At the Grand Junction and Centennial races the Senior L.O. 206 will have multiple weight classes, therefore CJKC points will be awarded to each place in each weight class.

Senior L.O. 206 Class Rules

- Ages 12 and up
- Minimum weight 360lbs
- Full Size Chassis

- Duro Tires 710/11-5 rear, 450/10-5 front
- Centrifugal drum style clutch with shoes only
- Rear brakes only
- Maximum Rear track width 55 1/8
- 2015 L.O. 206 Engine Class Regulations

Cash Prize Rules

To be eligible for a cash prize the winner must be a **CJKC Senior Member** prior to qualifing on race day.

If a previous cash prize winner takes first place at another cash prize race event the prize winner will be determined through a drawing that includes the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place drivers.

Must be 18 to win cash prize. If a driver under the age of 18 takes first place at a cash prize race event they will not be awarded a cash prize but will receive 2 free CJKC race entries to be used at later dates.

CJKC reserves the right to change the rules at any time.

2. ADULT CIKC Classes and Local Rules

In an attempt to make the race program run as efficient as possible, classes may race concurrently.

Karts that do not qualify within an existing class may be permitted to race, but must start all races from the rear of the field, will not collect points and will not be eligible for class prizes or awards. Additional classes can be formed with a minimum of 6 entries.

All classes will have rolling starts except for the Shifters. Shifters will have standing starts, subject to change without notice at the discretion of the race director.

Adults are responsible for providing their own transponder and ensuring it functions properly. CJKC will NOT rent transponders to adults. Transponders can be leased at mylaps.com.

All entrants will present kart, helmet, suit, gloves and neck collar for a prerace inspection.

It is required that any part, bolt or item that calls for safety wire, cotter pin or snap ring must be secured properly.

Full width rear bumpers are mandatory.

L.O. 206 Rules

- Ages 12 and up
- Minimum weight 360lbs
- Full Size Chassis
- Duro Tires 710/11-5 rear, 450/10-5 front
- Centrifugal drum style clutch with shoes only
- Rear brakes only
- Maximum Rear track width 55 1/8
- 2015 L.O. 206 Engine Class Regulations

Open Tag Rules

- Ages16 and up
- Minimum 365lbs
- Open Tires
- Open Fuel
- Full Rear width bumpers
- Rear brakes only
- Maximum Rear track width 55 1/8

Open Shifter Rules

- Ages 16 and up
- Maximum 125cc 2 stroke or 250cc 4 stroke engines
- Minimum 385lbs
- Open Tires
- Open Fuel
- Maximum Rear track width 55 1/8

Rules are subject to change to ensure a competitive and safe event.

Please refer to the 2015 IKF Regulations for general rules and procedures. Tag and Shifter engines will not be inspected.
